Above all 'Benatar' is a good, stout, solid name that lends herself to a long and varied career; featuring a keg conditioned version for the Handpump (Flat Benatar) and a barrel aged release (Vat Benatar) to name but two...

Style-wise she belongs somewhere between a Sweet Stout and a Black IPA. A rich malt profile in combination with flaked oats and a pinch of lactose give her the smooth, slick and full body of an Oatmeal or Milk Stout, while hitting the highway with Hops gives her the lingering bitterness of something far more sinister.

Bittersweet Stout isn't a style, but it is Benatar. Just the right kind of sinner...
