Our annual Good Beer Wheaty collaboration with Darren ‘Doc’ Robinson that will, quite literally, take your breath away...

Smoke: a rich, sweet, mellow smoke courtesy of Gladfield Manuka Smoked Malt that ‘brought back childhood campfire memories’ for Doc and smelled great to us West Islanders.

Roast: subtle; with just enough Carafa III to turn it black.

Hops: not so subtle; big orange, lime, pine and resin from Amarillo, Tassie Cascade and Simcoe & a fair shot of bitterness from Centennial.

Heat: pepper spray; only more enjoyable. Doc arrived packing heat in the form of Smoked Chipotle Oil; intense, spicy and pungent, more ‘shortness of breath’ than ‘burn’ (yes, speaking from experience).

Result: ‘a balanced smoky black IPA with warming heat and crisp bitterness’ Doc. Proceed with caution.
